CCPS G-SUITE STUDENT USE POLICY

- Although Google is a privately owned company, Clayton County Public Schools is the sole administrator of the domain. While we encourage our students to use the G Suite tools available to them, **students and parents should be aware these accounts are managed, monitored, and archived by Clayton County Public Schools and there should be no expectation of privacy, related to any CCPS digital resources;** meaning the district reserves the right to access, monitor, and review content in the G Suite for Education platform at any time. Any inappropriate behavior through the student's G Suite account is considered a violation of the CCPS Acceptable Use Policy.
- Access to and use of G Suite for Education is considered a privilege provided at the discretion of Clayton County Public Schools.

G-SUITE STUDENT USE POLICY

- The CCPS district maintains the right to immediately withdraw access to and use of the account if it is believed that violations of law or school board policies have occurred. In such cases, the alleged violation will be referred to the principal for further investigation and application of necessary consequences as indicated in the Student Code of Conduct.
